## Sub5 Race Series Rules <br> *Rules subject to change pending number of races and Covid-19 impact

*You must complete 5 series races to be eligible for an award.
*The age category of each runner is determined by their age at the first series race they enter for the calendar year.
*The top 10 runners in each age group receive points for each series race they complete. ( 1 st $=10$ points, 2 nd $=9$ points, etc.)
*Awards are based on the runner's total points from their 5 best series performances.
*Awards are presented to the male and female with the highest point total overall, regardless of age category. These 2 runners are not eligible for an age group award.
*Awards are presented to the top 3 runners in the following age groups: $0-12,13-18,19-29,30-39,40-49,50-59,60-64$, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79 \& 80+.
*In the event of a tie, each runner's next best race performance (6th, 7th, etc.) is considered until the tie is broken and a winner is determined. If the winner cannot be determined, the runners may share the award as follows: Tie for 1st and 2nd place award is combined and divided evenly. Tie for 2nd and 3rd place award is combined and divided evenly. Tie for 3rd each runner receives a full award.
